Information on how to get to the Venues of the Milano Cortina 2026 Olympic Games

Dear Sir or Madam,

The Milano Cortina 2026 Olympic Games will take place from **06 February to 22 February 2026**. Below you will find all essential information on how to reach the venues in South Tyrol (Antholz/Anterselva) as well as the surrounding regions (Cortina d'Ampezzo, Val di Fiemme and Livigno).

Please note that short-notice changes are possible. All information is therefore provided **without guarantee**.

The **Guest Pass Portal** guestpass.suedtirol.info and the text in the email used to send the Südtirol Guest Pass have been updated with the most important travel information for the Olympic Games.

The **Südtirol Guest Pass** is valid on all **südtirolmobil** routes during the games. Some shuttle services to competition venues outside South Tyrol require an additional fee.

Timetable for the public transport and shuttles in South Tyrol can be found in the **südtirolmobil app** or on suedtirolmobil.info.

Antholz/Anterselva

The Antholz Biathlon Arena will host the **biathlon** competitions of the Olympic Games.

Important note:



Please allow sufficient time for travel and security checks.

Entrances to the Arena **open 3.5 hours before competition start**.

Approximate travel time from Olang/Valdaora to the Arena is **about 1.5 hours**.

Train:



Transfers from train to shuttle buses take place at **Olang-Antholz/Valdaora-Anterselva station**. From there, shuttles run directly to Antholz/Anterselva. The **Pustertal Valley Railway** operates during the day at the usual **30-minute intervals** between **Franzensfeste/Fortezza** and **Innichen/San Candido**, and hourly to Lienz. In Franzensfeste/Fortezza there are connections to/from Brenner/Brennero, Bozen/Bolzano, Meran/Merano and Trento.

Additional services in the evening:

- **Regional trains** on the route **Franzensfeste/Fortezza – Innichen/San Candido** run till around midnight – [Timetable 400](#).
- From Olang-Antholz/Valdaora-Anterselva station there are additional buses [B400](#) to Bruneck/Brunico and Dobbiaco/Toblach.

Tickets: All **südtirolmobil Tickets** (including the **Südtirol Guest Pass**) are **valid**.

Park & Ride:



A restricted traffic zone begins at the roundabout in Niederrasen/Rasun di Sotto (valley entrance). Transit is only permitted for vehicles with Car Pass or a valid Olympic Ticket. Free Park & Ride facilities are available in **Antholz Mittertal/Anterselva di Mezzo** and **Olang/Valdaora (near the station)**. No reservation is required. For people with disabilities or fan groups arriving by bus, reservation options are available (see *links below*). It is recommended to travel by train to the train station of Olang-Antholz/Valdaora-Anterselva and use shuttles from there.

Shuttle Service:



At **Olang-Antholz/Valdaora-Anterselva** station, visitors can change to the organizer's **Shuttle Service B**, which takes them directly to Antholz Mittertal/Anterselva di Mezzo. From there, it is a 5-minute walk (300 m) where the **Shuttle Service A** departs. This shuttle brings guests to approximately a 15-minute walk (850 m) from the Biathlon Arena. Additionally, **Shuttle Service C** operates from Olang/Valdaora and Rasen/Rasun, stopping at all stops, to Antholz Mittertal/Anterselva di Mezzo.

The shuttle services in Antholz/Anterselva are free of charge – Timetable Shuttle.

Line 431 operates till the bus stop "Wildgall" at regular fares during the Games but is not recommended for access to the events.

Cortina d'Ampezzo

Cortina hosts the **curling, bobsleigh, skeleton and luge** competitions, as well as the **women's alpine skiing** events.



Important note:

Please allow sufficient time for travel and security checks.

Train:



Transfers from train to shuttle buses take place at **Toblach/Dobbiaco station**. From there, shuttles run directly to Cortina. The **Pustertal Valley Railway** operates during the day at the usual **30-minute intervals** between **Franzensfeste/Fortezza** and **Innichen/San Candido**, and hourly to Lienz.

Additional services in the evening:

- **Regional trains** on the route **Franzensfeste/Fortezza – Innichen/San Candido** run till around midnight – [Timetable 400](#).
- From Toblach/Dobbiaco station there are additional buses [B400](#) to Bruneck/Brunico and [B500](#) to Innichen/S. Candido.

Tickets: All **südtirolmobil Tickets** (including the **Südtirol Guest Pass**) are valid.

Park & Ride:



- **Arrival via Toblach/Dobbiaco:** A restricted traffic zone starts at Schluderbach/Carbonin. Transit is only permitted for authorized vehicles. **Free Park & Ride facilities with reservation** required are available **near Toblach/Dobbiaco station** (*see link below*). Recommended to travel by train to Toblach/Dobbiaco.
- **Arrival via Falzarego Pass:** A P+R car park is available at **Son dei Prade**. The P+R is subject to **fees and reservation** (*see link below*). From there, Cortina can be reached by shuttles and gondolas.

Shuttle Service:



At **Toblach/Dobbiaco** station, visitors can take the organizer's **shuttle** to the "*Cortina Sud Bus Terminal Spettatori*". From there, the venues are reachable on foot or by gondola.

The shuttle services are fee-based, tickets available online (*see link below*).

The public line 445 operates at regular fares and timetable during the Games but is not recommended for access to the venues.

Fiemme Valley (Predazzo and Tesero)

Val di Fiemme will host the ski jumping and cross-country skiing competitions.



Important note:

Please allow sufficient time for travel and security checks.

Train:



Transfers from train to shuttle buses occur at **Auer/Ora station**. From there, shuttles run directly to Predazzo and Tesero. The **Brenner/Brennero railway** is reinforced in the morning and evening and generally operates at **30-minute intervals** between **Bozen/Bolzano** and **Trento**; there are also additional services and 'Regionale Veloce' trains to/from Brenner/Brennero and Verona – [Timetable 100](#).

Tickets: All südtirolmobil Tickets (including the Südtirol Guest Pass) are valid.

Park & Ride:



Several Park & Ride facilities are available with a required **fee and reservation** (see [link below](#)). From the P+R sites, the venues are reached by shuttle service. There is no parking available for the competitions at Auer/Ora train station.
It is recommended to travel by train to Auer/Ora and use the shuttles from there.

Shuttle Service:



At **Auer/Ora** station, visitors can board the Trentino Trasporti **shuttle service** to the '**Tesero Bus Terminal**' and '**Predazzo Bus Terminal**'. From there, the venues are within walking distance (see [link below](#)). The service is offered starting approximately **three hours before the competitions begin**.

Additionally, **public bus line B101** by Trentino Trasporti **operates hourly** from Auer/Ora with intermediate stops at *Montan Dolomitenstraße/Montagna strada delle Dolomiti, Aldeiner Brücke/Ponte Aldino, Kaltenbrunn/Fontanefredde (junction to Truden/Tredena), and S. Lugano Kirche/Chiesa, to Tesero, Piazza Battisti and Predazzo Rotatoria Nord* – [Timetable B101](#). From Tesero and Predazzo, you can reach the venues on foot or by shuttle service. The südtirolmobil line 140 operates at regular fares and timetables between Auer/Ora and Cavalese.

Guests from the **Eggental/Val d'Ega** can take südtirolmobil **line 180 to Vigo di Fassa** and transfer to Trentino Trasporti line B101. From Bozen/Bolzano, traveling via Auer/Ora is recommended.

The shuttle service and Trentino Trasporti public lines in Val di Fiemme and Val di Fassa are free of charge during the Games with a valid competition ticket.

Livigno

Livigno will host the **snowboard and freestyle ski competitions**.

Vinschgau/Venosta Valley Railway replacement service:



For visitors to these competitions, the **replacement service B250** on the **Schlanders/Silandro – Mals/Malles** section has been expanded. At **Mals/Malles** station, passengers can transfer to **regional bus 811** towards **Zernez** as far as Müstair or Punt-La-Drossa, where shuttle services to Livigno operate.



On **some evenings**, there are direct connections from **Livigno to Mals/Malles**. For these direct connections, **onward travel to Schlanders/Silandro via replacement service B250 is possible** – [Timetable B250](#).

Tickets: südtirolmobil tickets (including the Südtirol Guest Pass) are valid on line B250 and line 811 for the section *Mals Bahnhof/Malles Stazione – Müstair, Cunfin* (border). Beyond that point, tickets must be purchased (see link below).

Park & Ride:



For visitors arriving by private car, the '**Müstair P&R Olimpico**' is available south of the village of Müstair. From there, a direct shuttle runs to Livigno. The P+R facility is **subject to fees**. Transit through the Munt-la-Schera tunnel to Livigno is not possible with a car during the Games.

Shuttle Service:



Passengers on line 811 can transfer at **Müstair Clostra, Müstair Posta** or the stop **Punt la Drossa P4** (near the Munt-la-Schera tunnel toll station) to shuttle line 815 to Livigno. Connections are available (with stops on the route)
